## For the COACH/SCHOOL REPRESENTATIVE

## For the PLAYER

- Sportsmanship: Always show respect to opponents, officials, coaches, and teammates.
  Play with fairness and a positive attitude, regardless of the outcome of the game.
- Effort and Focus: Give your best effort, stay focused, and support your teammates.
  Work hard to improve your skills and contribute to the team.
- Respect Authority: Follow the instructions of coaches and officials. If you have concerns, communicate them in a respectful manner.
- Keep it Fun: Remember that sports are about having fun and learning. Stay positive, support others, and enjoy the experience.
- Safety: Always prioritize your own safety and the safety of others. Inform coaches and officials immediately if you are injured or feel unwell.
